MAXIMIZE SCHOOL SUCCESS



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Parents of children with special healthcare needs should use the following as a guide to help their child succeed in school.

Understand the legal protections for your child with special health care needs.

Learn about the legal protections that guarantee access to education for your child.

Request educational services for your child.

Request educational services, such as an IEP or Section 504 plan, to meet your child's educational needs

Gather information.

Gather information about how your child's special health care need might impact his or her educational experience.

Meet with school personnel.

Build a relationship with your child's teacher and the educational team to help meet your child's needs.

Organize the information.

Organize and package the information you gathered so you can present it to the school and request educational services and accommodations.

Prepare your child.

Develop your child's self-advocacy and coping skills to help him or her manage their special health care needs in school.

Review and revise progress.

Once educational accommodations are in place, periodically review your child's progress, and work with the school to revise your child's accommodations.
